Can an organization with less than 5-years of experience submit a proposal? We believe that our team members have qualifications and lots of experience relevant for this assignment.	Yes, organization that has less than 5-years of experience can submit a proposal. Please make sure that your proposal addresses all the selection criteria and be submitted with all required documents as per the RFP.
Is it possible for an organization, who did not participate in KSI Workshop in Makassar on May 2019, to submit a proposal? Is it possible to get access to the workshop report?	Yes, you can submit a proposal regardless your participation in Makassar Workshop. A draft report is provided here for information in this procurement process only. Please do not further circulate this draft report.
Do attachment A and B of the RFP have to be signed when sending the proposal?	No, signing the attachment A and B are not required when applicant submits a proposal. Once selected, the applicant must complete and sign the solicitation/RFP.
Is the proposal made for Stage One only? (August-October 2019)	No, the proposal should clearly explain what to do in Stage One and discuss potential activities in Stage 2. This will be reflected in your budget proposal, which should include detailed budget for Stage One and an indicative budget for Stage 2.
Is there a budget ceiling specified for the Proposal?	Yes, the budget ceiling for this proposal is Rp 750,000,000 (seven hundred fifty million rupiahs).
